## Saka Sri Nankana Sahib

The cruel and cold-blooded massacre of the Sikh devotees at Nankana Sahib-the birth place of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, now situated in Pakistan, took place on February 21,1921 at the behest of wily and unscrupulous Mahant Narain Das who, unfortunately for the Sikhs, managed the affairs of the holy place at that time. A group of more than two hundred Sikh devotees had gone to make obeisance as well as to liberate the holy shrine from the control of the Mahant by non-violent and peaceful means.



In Guru Granth Sahib, many devotional hymns of Bhagat Ravidas are present. He was devotee of God, and his hymns are placed under Bani Bhagatan ki.

Guru Arjan Dev ji decided to include the works of Ravidas in the Shri Guru Granth Sahib. There are 41 verses of Ravidas, most of which are in very clear Hindi. His poetry is brimming with ardent love for God, Universe, Nature, Guru, and Naam.



Once again the Manohar Singh Jatha shared Shabad 'Agya Bhai Akaal Ki' with our Punjabi class school children gathered in the presence of the Saadh Sangat. The planned last ten minutes were taken by Jasmer Singh and Kavya Kaur, setting an example for other children.
